7 **ORDER OF COURT**

8 AND NOW, this 10th day of April, 2013, the Court hereby Orders that
9 the Adams County Rules of Judicial Administration shall be amended as
10 follows:
11

12 440. Petition for Appointment to Fill Vacancy in Office of Constable-

13 A. Any person seeking to be appointed to serve as constable to serve a
14 vacancy in said office pursuant to 44 Pa. C.S.A. § 7121 shall file petition in
15 the Adams County Clerk of Courts Office. The petition shall include the
16 following:

- 17 1. A statement identifying the borough, city, ward, or township in which a
18 vacancy exists;
19
20 2. The expiration date of the term of office for which the appointment is
21 being sought;
22
23 3. A statement that the petitioner is a resident of the municipality where
24 the vacancy exists; and
25
4. A statement that the petitioner has or will satisfy all the statutory
requirements to serve as a constable.

2 B. The petition shall be signed by ten (10) qualified electors residing in the
3 borough, city, ward, or township in which the vacancy exists. In addition
4 to original signature, each qualified elector shall be identified by printed
5 name and address.

7 C. Upon the filing of a petition in compliance with the requirements of this
8 rule, the Adams County Clerk of Courts Office shall forward the same to
9 the President Judge, or designee, within five (5) business days of the filing
10 of the same. The President Judge, or designee, shall schedule hearing or
11 take other appropriate action as necessary.

12 This rule shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication in the
13 Pennsylvania Bulletin. It is further directed that:

14
15 a. This Order shall be filed in the Office of the Prothonotary of Adams
16 County and a copy thereof shall be filed with the Adams County Clerk
17 of Courts and the Adams County Law Library for inspection and
18 copying;

19 b. Seven (7) certified copies of this Order shall be forwarded to the
20 Administrative Office of the Pennsylvania Courts for distribution in
21 accordance with the provisions of Pa. R.J.A. No. 103(c)(2); and

22 c. Two (2) certified copies of this Order together with a computer
23 diskette that complies with the requirement of 1 Pa. Code §13.11 (b), or
24 other compliant format per 1 Pa. Code §13.11 (d), containing the test of
