No. 11 of 2019**

ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 9th day of July, 2019, it is hereby Ordered:

1. All divorce master hearings conducted by court appointed masters shall be held in the Human Services Building Courtroom on either Monday or Friday of each respective week. Scheduling for divorce master hearings shall be arranged by the court appointed master with the Court Administrator's Office;
2. All divorce master hearings shall be considered a hearing before a court of record with the proceedings digitally recorded. Upon scheduling of a divorce master hearing, the Court Administrator's Office shall make arrangements for necessary personnel to digitally record the proceeding. Private stenographers shall not be utilized for purposes of maintaining the hearing record;
3. All requests for transcripts from divorce master hearing proceedings shall be made pursuant to Local Rules of Judicial Administration 407, 408, 409, and 411. In the event the presiding master requires preparation of transcript to assist in preparing a recommendation, the master shall make the request through the Family Law Administrative Judge; and
4. This Order shall be effective for all hearings scheduled to be held after August 2, 2019. Hearings which are scheduled to be held after August 2, 2019 shall be rescheduled in compliance with this Order.
