**ORDER OF COURT**

AND NOW, this 9<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2013, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 3804(f.1), that any person who violates 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 3802 shall attend a Victim Impact Panel Program as part of the conditions of their sentence. The Victim Impact Panel shall be administrated through the Adams County Victim Witness Program in conjunction with the Adams County Department of Probation Services as part of the DUI Education Program. The program shall be operated in consultation with Mothers Against Drunk Driving-Pennsylvania State Organization.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Adams County Clerk of Courts Office shall assess as costs a \$10 participation fee in each case where a person is convicted or placed on an alternative disposition program for a violation under 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 3802. The fee shall be payable to the Adams County General Fund, however, shall be designated as a restrictive fund utilized solely by the Adams County Victim Witness Program for purposes of operating the Victim Impact Panel.

The fee imposed herein shall be assessed effective June 1, 2013 in every case in which conviction or placement in an alternative disposition program occurs subsequent to that date.
