ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 1st day of November, 2010, effective November 15, 2010, laundry fees and drug testing fees will be collected from all persons housed at the Re-Entry Facility. The fee shall be \$3 per week for laundry and \$12 per week for urinalysis testing. The collected fees shall be deposited in the currently designated budget categories. Failure to pay the fee shall be a basis for revocation and/or removal from the Re-Entry Facility unless indigent. If an individual is indigent, the fees shall accrue until employment or other income is obtained at which time the accrued fee shall be paid pursuant to payment policy enacted by the Adams County Prison.
