ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 22nd day of December, 2011, Administrative Order No. 12 of 2011 is amended to reflect that the Adams County Clerk of Courts Office is directed to promptly enter judgment in the Adams County Prothonotary's Office against any defendant where a defendant is directed to pay costs, fees, fines, or restitution in an amount in excess of \$499. Judgment shall not be entered in cases where costs, fees, fines, or restitution do not total at least \$500. Judgment shall be entered promptly following imposition of sentence by the Court.

The provision in Administrative Order No. 12 of 2011 providing that judgment may not be entered until at least thirty (30) days of entry of the Order directing payment is VACATED. This Order shall supersede any contrary provision in Administrative Order No. 12 of 2011. In all other respects, Administrative Order No. 12 of 2011 shall remain in full force and effect.
