**ORDER OF COURT**

AND NOW, this 8<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2012, it is hereby Ordered that the Adams County Clerk of Courts Office is authorized to make payment to the Pennsylvania Victims Compensation Board in lieu of restitution to a specific victim, upon receipt of memorandum from the Adams County Victim Witness Program that the Board has made direct payment to the victim or on behalf of the victim. The memorandum shall identify the amount of restitution, the payee as designated in the sentencing Order, and a request to substitute the Pennsylvania Victims Compensation Board as the payee.

The amount of restitution shall not, without Order of Court, exceed the amount identified in the sentencing Order payable to a specific payee. On the other hand, where payment by the Pennsylvania Victims Compensation Board on behalf of a victim has reduced the amount of restitution due to the payee/victim, the Clerk of Courts Office, upon memorandum from the Adams County Victim Witness Program, may reduce the amount of restitution owed by an offender.
