**ADAMS COUNTY DETECTIVES MAKE THREE ARRESTS INVOLVING CHILD
EXPLOITATION**

Adams County District Attorney Brian Sinnett announced today that Adams County Detectives recently made three arrests of subjects involved in using the internet to exploit children. *See attached Criminal Complaints and Affidavits of Probable Cause.* On December 4, 2019, Ivy Mays, Thomasville, was arrested for Possession and Distribution of Child Pornography and related offenses. A victim filed a complaint with local police that was referred to the District Attorney's Office for investigation. This investigation revealed that Mays used the popular internet platform Facebook to disseminate explicit images of the juvenile victim to random strangers that contacted her through a private chat group, leading to the continued exploitation of this juvenile.

On December 9, 2019, Juan Aguilar Jr. of New Oxford was arrested for Possession of Child Pornography and related offenses. The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children informed detectives of a complaint of child exploitation. Investigators found that Aguilar used Twitter to access and save a video compilation of several juveniles being sexually assaulted.

On December 12, 2019, Luke Curry of Hanover was arrested for Possession and Distribution of Child Pornography, Possession with Intent to Distribute Controlled Substances, and Prohibited Offensive Weapons. Curry used peer-to-peer file sharing software to download and share images of children being sexually exploited. A search warrant at his residence revealed explicit images of children, as well as controlled substances and an illegal weapon.

The Adams County Detectives were supported in these investigations by various local, state, and federal law enforcement partners, including the PA State Police, the PA Office of Attorney General, The FBI, Homeland Security Investigations, as well as Reading Township Police, Latimore Township Police, Eastern Adams Regional Police, Conewago Township Police, McSherrystown Police, and Adams County Adult Probation Services.

In this case, as with all criminal cases, the defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty.

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Detective Eric B. Beyer of the Adams County District Attorney's Office, believe the following information to be sufficient probable cause to charge Ivy Taylor Mays with the offenses listed on the attached Criminal Complaint.

Between 19 August 2019 and 20 August 2019, Ivy Taylor Mays possessed and disseminated images of the victim, A.M., while A.M. was under the age of 18 years old. These images depicted A.M.'s nude breasts. Ivy Taylor Mays dissipated these images to six people after being warned by A.M. not to share these images, and after learning that A.M. was under the age of 18 years old. Ivy Taylor Mays used Facebook Messenger, an internet based communications facility, and her cellular telephone, to dissiminate these images.

On 5 November 2019, Ivy Taylor Mays was interviewed and admitted to responsibility for this incident.

Based upon the above stated information, I ask that Ivy Taylor Mays answer to the charges set forth.

I, Eric B. Beyer, BEING DULY SWORN ACCORDING TO THE LAW, DEPOSE AND SAY THAT THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE FOREGOING AFFIDAVIT ARE TRUE AND CORRECT TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE, INFORMATION AND BELIEF.





AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Detective Eric B. Beyer of the Adams County District Attorney's Office, believe the following information to be sufficient probable cause to charge Juan Aguilar Jr. with the offenses listed on the attached Criminal Complaint.

On 6 September 2019, I was assigned to investigate CybertipLine Report 52802872, (CT Report) submitted by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. (NCMEC) This CT Report 52802872 was submitted by Google, Inc., which reported that a video file was found to be in the Google Drive Infrastructure. This video was discovered on 25 July 2019 at 18:22:38 UTC. As part of this report, NCMEC included the suspect file. This video file is a screen capture of several video clips that depict vaginal intercourse with children under the age of 18. This determination is made by my observation of the obvious underdeveloped bodies and faces of the children depicted. Some of the video captions are in Vietnamese. Using the online resource Google Translate, I was able to identify the videos as being reported to depict children 10 and 11 years of age being engaged in sexual acts.

Google included data related to the user account that was reported to have placed this video file into the Google Drive Infrastructure. This data included a user name of Juan Aguilar, email address of aguilarjuan15003@gmail.com and a cellular telephone number of 7174790497. I queried PennDot records for Juan Aguilar in New Oxford, PA, and discovered that Juan Aguilar Jr. lives at 13 Elm Lane, New Oxford, PA, 17350, in Adams County.

On Friday, 13 September 2019, using an undercover phone, I initiated a text conversation with the phone number 717-479-0497. During this text conversation, the user identified himself as Juan Aguilar Jr. On 13 September 2019, I prepared Administrative Subpoena AS19-13 for Verizon Wireless for the phone number 717-479-0497 and forwarded this subpoena to Verizon Wireless. On 18 September 2019, I received records created during the normal course of business from Verizon Wireless that reported that the subscriber information for the phone number 717-479-0497 is Juan Aguilar, 13 Elm Lane, New Oxford, PA 17350.



AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUATION

Based upon the Cybertip report information, the results of AS19-13, the communications with the phone number 717-479-0497, and the PennDot records which indicated that Juan Aguilar Jr. lives at 13 Elm Lane, New Oxford, PA 17350, a search warrant was prepared for 13 Elm Lane, for the computer systems therein. This search warrant was approved by MDJ Tony Little on 20 November 2019. On 21 November 2019, this search warrant was served. During the service of this search warrant, Juan Aguilar Jr. was contacted and asked to return to the residence. He did so, and his cellular telephone was seized and later examined. Aguilar admitted that the cellular phone was his, and provided the passcode for this phone.

Once Aguilar returned to the residence, he was advised of his Miranda Warnings and interviewed regarding this investigation. During this interview, Aguilar admitted to clicking on pornographic pop-up ads that looked interesting to him, including ones that involved children. Aguilar stated that 99% of what he looked up was legal, and he didn't think that he was doing anything wrong.

Aguilar's cellular phone was forensically examined. The video reported by NCMEC was found on this phone, as were search terms indicative of child pornography, including "jailbait" and "underage."

Based upon the above stated information, I ask that Juan Aguilar Jr. answer to the charges set forth.

On Saturday, November 23, 2019, I was conducting an online investigation on the BitTorrent network for offenders sharing child pornography. An investigation was initiated for a device at IP address 73.52.97.235. On 23 November 2019, the computer located at IP address 73.52.97.235 disseminated 98 images of child pornography to the undercover computer located at the Adams County District Attorney's Office. These files are defined as:

LS Star 016a - This series of images include 56 partial or full images of a white female wearing a white outfit with a pink and white top. 12 of these images show the female in stages of nudity, lewdly and lasciviously displaying her breasts, genitals, and / or buttocks.

LS Touch 018a - This series of images include 38 partial or full images of a white female wearing a peach colored outfit. One of these images depicts this female with her nude breasts exposed.

LS-island Issue 03 Midsummer Set 21 - This series of images depicts 68 full or partial images of a white female wearing a green bathing suit with red flowers and a pink and yellow scarf. The female has a yellow inflatable ring with a clear top. 19 of these images depict the female in various stages of nudity, lewdly and lasciviously displaying her breasts, buttocks, and / or genitals.



As a result of the above information, a search warrant was served on 10 Bear Court, Hanover, Conewago Township, Adams County, PA. During the service of this search warrant, investigators discovered a laptop computer and two USB thumb drives in a bedroom with mail addressed to the defendant, Luke Anthony Curry. These items were forensically examined, and the computer was found to contain 35 images of child pornography. The Dell USB thumb drive was found to contain 7 images of child pornography, and the Sandisk USB thumb drive was found to contain 20 images of child pornography.

Also found during the service of this search warrant was a plastic container with three bags of Marijuana, a Schedule I Controlled Substance. These three bags were each approximately an ounce in size.

Finally, investigators located an item described as brass knuckles, a prohibited offensive weapon as described by this act.
