FORMER ADAMS COUNTY PROBATION OFFICER CHARGED

Adams County District Attorney Brian Sinnett announced today that Wyatt Emerson Mowery, 23, of Newburg, Pennsylvania, a former Adams County Probation Officer, has been charged with ten misdemeanor offenses as a result of an inappropriate relationship with an individual he was to be supervising as a condition of their sentence. Sinnett announced that charges of Tampering with Records or Identification, Tampering With or Fabricating Physical Evidence, Tampering with Public Records or Information, and Obstructing Administration of Law or Other Governmental Function were filed against Mowery. The charges were filed as a result of a several week investigation that was brought to the attention of the Adams County Detectives in early December 2017. As a result of this investigation it was revealed that Mowery was attempting to have inappropriate intimate contact with an individual on supervision and had taken steps to either not supervise her appropriately, falsify entries into official records regarding the results of drug tests or destroying evidence relating to drug testing all together. *(See attached Criminal Complaint and Affidavit of Probable Cause.)*

Sinnett expressed his gratitude for the cooperation of the Adams County Probation Department and the diligence of Adams County Detectives Wade Lauer and Eric Beyer as well as Office of Attorney General throughout this investigation. “Although these offenses strike at the very core of the integrity of our criminal justice system. We certainly believe this is an isolated incident involving one particular rogue probation officer and is not indicative of the integrity of that department as a whole.”

As these are misdemeanor offenses, the charges were filed through Magisterial District Judge Mark Beauchat’s office via summons. No bail action has been taken nor has a preliminary hearing date been set. In this case, as with all criminal cases, the defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty.

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

On 7 December 2017, Detective Eric Beyer and I began an investigation into a possible violation of Title 18, Sections 5101, 4910, and 4911, in which it was alleged that Wyatt Mowery, a Probation Officer employed by the Adams County Department of Probation Services, had been in inappropriate contact with one of his clients via his county issued cellular phone and his personal cellular phone. As a result of this inappropriate contact, Mowery was possibly falsifying official probation records, failing to perform proper supervision of his clients, and/or tampering with or fabricating urine drug tests. Our investigation determined that the client in question was identified as Erika Sheely.

On December 19, 2017, I interviewed Erika Sheely. Sheely advised that her Probation Officer Wyatt Mowery, the defendant, had been "Snapchatting" and exchanging text messages with her. During these exchanges, Sheely indicated that some of the messages asked her out on dates, and some of the messages in her words were; "pretty vulgar". Sheely indicated that these messages were exchanged during the summer of 2017, and occurred between her telephone and the personal telephone of the defendant. Sheely advised that at some point Mowery told her that someone had approached him and told him that it had been rumored that he was exchanging messages with a client. Sheely advised that the defendant told her that they had to discontinue "Snapchatting", and if anyone ever asked her, that she should; "deny, deny, deny".

Sheely further indicated that in late October or November, she had been required to submit to a urinalysis test as a requirement of being on probation. As a result of that test, a faint positive result for use of a controlled substance was detected. Sheely indicated to this officer that she had been using at this time. After this test, Sheely advised that she had called the defendant, he had told her that the results would only go to him. She advised that no further action was taken on this test. Sheely advised that just before these tests, she had been at her counseling provider, who had conducted a test, and she had tested positive with that agency for a controlled substance.

Sheely stated that she was scheduled for an appointment at the Adams County Probation Office early in December 2017, to meet with the defendant. She indicated that on that occasion she did not have a urinalysis done to test her for a controlled substance.



AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUATION

Sheely stated that in early December, the defendant, as a probation officer had come to her home for an unannounced visit. When he knocked on her door, she initially did not answer. The defendant then called her and left a message that he had to meet with her on her phone. Sheely advised that she then texted the defendant and told him that she could not take a "pee test" today, and that if she did she would be in trouble, and he would be in trouble for the messages he had been sending her. Sheely advised that the defendant responded; "OK, I will call you in a minute". The defendant then called her and told her that she needed to "pee" in the cup, but, he promised her that she wouldn't go to jail. Sheely advised that the defendant arrived there, that she "peed" in a cup, and that he tested it, and said; "She is golden". Sheely advised that no further action was taken by the defendant, and he left. Sheely advised that during that period of time, she had been on a cocaine binge, and should have tested positive for cocaine.

I obtained the Adams County Adult Probation Journal Entries for: Sheely, Erika. These journals document actions taken regarding clients who are on probation. These documents are created by the supervising Probation Officer who is assigned. A notation was made in the journal for Sheely, by WMOWERY on 12/04/2017, that a U/A (urine analysis) was neg for all substances tested. Additionally a notation dated 12/05/2017 by WMOWERY documents a visit to the home of Sheely. That notation indicates; "Got U/A-was neg for 6 Panel"

Mowery's county issued cellular phone was seized from him. This cellular phone has the service provided through Verizon Wireless. The issued number to the cellular phone is 717-752-5699. This cellular phone was analyzed by the PA Office of Attorney General, and text and instant messages were recovered from Erika Sheely to Wyatt Mowery. The number used by Erika Sheely was 717-698-8952.

Mowery's personal cellular phone was also obtained and examined with his written consent. The forensic examination of his cellular phone showed text messages and telephone calls from his personal cell phone number of 717-360-4214 to Erika Sheely's cellular phone with the issued number of 717-698-8952. These text message conversations included text messages from Wyatt Mowery to Erika Sheely in which Wyatt Mowery discusses taking Erika Sheely to the Cheesecake Factory on a date.

Erika Sheely's cellular phone was obtained and examined. Instant messages were recovered that were sent from Erika Sheely, using the cell phone number 717-698-8952 to Mowery's work cell number of 717-752-5699. Specifically, an instant message from Sheely to Mowery that stated that Sheely had messages from Mowery in which Mowery had asked Sheely out, and had told Sheely that he, Mowery, wanted Sheely to be his "daddy's little cum slut," and stated that if he tested her, she would be in trouble, and if she was in trouble, then Mowery would be in trouble.

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUATION

The defendant was interviewed first on December 21, 2017, and at that time he confirmed that he had entered the documentation in the Adams County Adult Probation Journal for Erika Sheely. The defendant was again interviewed on December 27, 2017. During that interview the defendant indicated that he had gone to Sheely's home on December 5, 2017. At that time he had Sheely submit to a urinalysis for controlled substances. Sheely had done so, and when he had tested the sample, the result was a "faint" positive for controlled substances. He further stated that he should have sent the sample away for further testing, but, did not do so. When asked why he had not, he indicated that he did not have a good answer for that. When asked if it was because Sheely would do something to turn him in, he responded; "Maybe".

Based upon this information, I ask that Wyatt Emerson Mowery answer to the charges set forth.
