Adams County District Attorney Brian Sinnett announced today that charges have been filed against Brian Daniel King, 31, of New Oxford, Pennsylvania for crimes related to Criminal Attempt and Criminal Solicitation to have sexual contact with a 15-year-old. Specifically, King was charged with Solicitation to Commit Corruption of Minors, as well as Unlawful Contact with a Minor (3 counts), Solicitation to Commit Sexual Abuse of Children, Criminal Use of a Communication Facility, and Solicitation Regarding Obscene and other Sexual Materials. Adams County Detective Eric Beyer, who is also a member of Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (ICAC), conducted an undercover investigation after receiving solicitation from the defendant to engage in inappropriate contact with one another. Detective Beyer assumed the role of a child in communication with the defendant which caused the defendant to not only offer illegal images of himself, but also request sexual contact from the undercover officer believing he was a 15-year-old girl. *See attached Criminal Complaint and Affidavit of Probable Cause.*

King was taken into custody today by members of the Adams County Detectives and Sinnett wished to commend Detective Beyer and Detective Wade Lauer for their diligent and thorough investigation into this matter. Also, Sinnett wishes to stress to the public that parents, guardians and concerned adults are encouraged to discuss safe social media usage with their children and to remind children they should report to adults any illicit conversations or images and videos.

Each of the charged offenses against King is graded as a Felony of the Third Degree and carries with it up to seven years in prison. King was taken to the Adams County Adult Correctional Complex to await preliminary arraignment before a Magisterial District Judge and no bail has been set yet nor has a preliminary hearing date been established.

In this case, as with all criminal cases, the defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty.



## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

I, Detective Eric B. Beyer of the Adams County District Attorney's Office, believe the following information to be sufficient probable cause to charge Brian Daniel King with the offenses listed on the attached Criminal Complaint.

On 23 January 2019, I was engaged in undercover chat activities on the online chat application "Skout". My online persona was that of a 15 year old female. During this undercover activity, I was contacted by a profile with the user name of Brian, with an attached image. Immediately upon being contacted, I informed Brian that I was 15, and that I had mistakenly listed my age as 25. I informed him that I was trying to fix that. Brian continued the conversation and asked if I liked older guys. I answered affirmatively and asked if he was okay with my age, which I again stated was "15", which he answered affirmatively.

On 24 January 2019, I was again contacted on "Skout" by Brian, who asked if I wanted to see "how huge" he was. After he had asked this, he sent an image of his naked and erect penis to the undercover persona that he knew and acknowledged was 15 years old. He then asked if I received the image, and asked me if I liked it. Shortly thereafter, I feigned issues with the application "Skout" and asked if he wanted to text instead. Brian provided me with the phone number 717-353-4311 with which to text him. I texted him and confirmed that the person I was texting was Brian. He indicated that it was, and referenced the previously described picture. He then asked me if I had ever "played with one", and asked me if I'd be interested in "playing with it." He then asked me for a picture of myself. I provided a previously obtained image of a police officer, specifically used for these investigations, and he told me that there was no way I was 15, unless I was a model, again referencing the age of my undercover persona.

During the conversation with Brian, he explicitly communicated with me, soliciting me to perform oral sex on him, providing me with suggested techniques for doing so, asked me if I wanted him to take my virginity,



(Continued from page 1) offered to "play with" my vagina, and asked me if I played with myself. We made arrangements to meet at the Sheetz on Baltimore Pike in Adams County PA. After the agreed upon time without Brian arriving, I cancelled the meeting and accused him of lying to me. Brian informed me that he hadn't lied, but had gone to the wrong location. I told him that I believed that he wasn't even the guy in the profile, and asked him to send me an image of his face with four fingers being held up, which he did within moments of my asking him to do so.

Using the original image in the Skout profile, which was confirmed by the image that Brian sent to me upon my request, I asked the PA Criminal Intelligence Center to perform a facial recognition search of males named Brian living in the New Oxford area. PACIC provided me with an image match for the defendant, who was identified as Brian Daniel King. One of the images that PACIC provided was a booking photo from an arrest conducted by the Adams County District Attorney's Office. I reviewed and compared the images and confirmed that Brian Daniel King was the person that sent me an image via text message, as well as the profile image of Brian that was on Skout.

After this failed meeting, I ended contact with Brian. On 25 January 2019, Brian initiated contact with my undercover phone number via text. Brian again stated that he was interested in meeting me at Sheetz at 3:30 on the 25th of January, 2019, and asked if he should bring a condom. He further asked if I was "ok with a stranger teaching" me "the ways?", and if I was ok with my first sexual experience to happen in a car. He later asked if I wore thongs or panties, and asked if he could perform oral sex on me. He further asked if I was sure that I wanted to lose my virginity to an older guy like him, and told me that if we had sex, I was going to sit on his lap on his penis. He also asked if I was okay with being naked outside in a car in daylight, and asked me if I was going to wear something sexy for him. Brian failed to appear for this second meeting, and I ended contact with him.

Based upon the above stated information, I ask that Brian Daniel King answer to the charges set forth.
