CUMBERLAND TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Notice is hereby given that a hearing will be held on ~~Wednesday~~ August 31, 2016 at 11:00 a.m., prevailing time, in Courtroom No. 1, fourth floor, of the Adams County Courthouse, 117 Baltimore Street, Adams County, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania 17325, on a Petition of the Adams County Board of Elections to realign the boundaries of the Cumberland Township election districts in order to more nearly equalize Township election district populations. At the time of the November 3, 2015, Municipal Election, there were 1,721 electors registered in current Election District No. 3, and 652 electors registered in current Election District No. 4. Proposed Election District No. 3 would contain 1,295 electors, and proposed Election District No. 4 would contain 1,215 electors. The proposed election districts are bounded and described as follows, and are as shown on the accompanying map:

Proposed Election District No. 3: The boundary would begin at the intersection of Knoxlyn and Old Mill Roads, continue west along the border between Cumberland and Highland Townships until intersecting the common border point among Cumberland, Highland and Franklin Townships. The boundary would then travel northeast along the border between Cumberland and Franklin Townships, until intersecting Mummasburg Road. The boundary would then travel southeast in the centerline of Mummasburg Road (SR 3017), being the border between proposed Election District No. 3 and existing Election District No. 1, for the entire distance of Mummasburg Road through Cumberland Township, until meeting the boundary between Cumberland Township and the Borough of Gettysburg. The boundary would then continue south along the border between Gettysburg Borough and Cumberland Township, until meeting Fairfield Road (SR 0116). The proposed boundary would then continue along the centerline of Fairfield Road to the southwest, between proposed Election District No. 3 to the north, and proposed Election District No. 4 to the south. This leg would finish where the unnamed tributary of Willoughby Run crosses under Fairfield Road, approximately 1,260 feet past the intersection of Fairfield Road with Willoughby Run Road. The boundary would then travel northward along the unnamed tributary of Willoughby Run, until meeting Old Mill Road, after which the boundary would then travel northwest along the centerline of Old Mill Road, until reaching the point of its beginning at the intersection of Old Mill Road and Knoxlyn Road.

Proposed Election District No. 4: The boundary would start at the southwest corner of the existing Election District No. 3, being the boundary of Cumberland and Highland Townships at the point Fairfield Road (SR 0116) crosses Marsh Creek. It would then continue northwest along the boundary between Cumberland and Highland Townships, until meeting the intersection of Knoxlyn Road and Old Mill Road. The boundary would then travel southeast in the centerline of Old Mill Road, crossing Herra Ridge Road, until coming to an unnamed tributary of Willoughby Run. The boundary would then travel south along the unnamed tributary, passing between census block 2025 to the east (and the homes located on Twin Lakes Drive), and census block 2027 to the west (containing the homes along Friendship Lane, Kestrel Drive, Fairplay Road, and the additional homes of the Twin Lakes West Development, among others). Upon reaching Fairfield Road the boundary would regain its original course, continuing to the northeast along the centerline of Fairfield Road, until reaching the boundary with the Borough of Gettysburg. The boundary would then travel southeast along the boundary of Cumberland Township and the Borough of Gettysburg, until intersecting Emmitsburg Road (SR 3001). The boundary would then continue to the southwest along the centerline of Emmitsburg Road (SR 3001), for its entire length through Cumberland Township, until coming to the boundary of Cumberland and Freedom Townships. The boundary would then continue to the north along the boundary of Cumberland and Freedom Townships, until coming to the point where the boundaries of Cumberland, Freedom and Highland Townships meet. The boundary would then continue west, north and east along the boundary of Cumberland and Highland Townships until coming to the point where Fairfield Road crosses Marsh Creek along the boundary of Cumberland and Highland Townships, being the place of the beginning.
