## **PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETINGS FOR ONWARD2050, ADAMS COUNTY'S DRAFT LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (LRTP) – TOMORROW!**

Two public information meetings for Adams County's Draft Long Range Transportation Plan and Air Quality Conformity (AQCA) Report will be held tomorrow - July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 10 am and 6 pm. These meetings are being held as part of the 30-day public review and comment period and will be conducted using a hybrid format with the option for in-person or virtual attendance.

ONWARD2050 identifies the county's long-term transportation needs and strategies for improving the transportation network. It also lists the projected future funding **allocations for highway, bridge, safety, and active transportation projects for the next 28 years.
