REMINDER – APPLICATIONS FOR THE MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION FUND ACCEPTED THROUGH NOVEMBER 5, 2021

PennDOT will be accepting applications for FY 2022-2023 Multimodal Transportation Fund (MTF) through November 5, 2021 at 4PM. Act 89 established a dedicated Multimodal Transportation Fund that stabilizes funding for ports and rail freight, increases aviation investments, establishes dedicated funding for bicycle and pedestrian improvements, and allows targeted funding for priority investments in any mode. GREEN LIGHT-GO FUNDING PROGRAM - APPLICATION PERIOD ANNOUNCED

PennDOT will be accepting applications for the Green Light-Go Funding Program (Year 7) from October 18, 2021 through January 14, 2022. It is estimated there will be approximately \$40 million available in State Fiscal Year 2022-23 for the competitive application and reimbursement grant program for existing traffic signal improvements. Projects awarded in this round must be completed by spring 2025.
