### Municipal COVID Response and Planning Eligible Expenditures

The Municipal COVID Response and Planning Program aims to help Adams County Municipalities mitigate the negative financial impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency. During the application process, it is important that municipalities demonstrate the incurred costs/costs to be incurred are directly related to circumstances of COVID-19. Costs must have been incurred between March 1st, 2020 and December 31st, 2020 and must not be accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020. Eligible expenditures of the Municipal COVID Response and Planning Program include but are not limited to:

- Expenses for COVID-19 testing
- Acquisition and distribution of medical and protective supplies, including sanitizing products and personal protective equipment, for medical personnel, police officers, social workers, child protection services, and child welfare officers, direct service providers for older adults and individuals with disabilities in community settings, and other public health or safety workers in connection with the COVID-19 public health emergency
- Disinfection of public areas and other facilities
- Purchase of cleaning and disinfecting supplies/services
- Technical assistance to local authorities or other entities on mitigation of COVID-19-related threats to public health and safety
- Public safety measures undertaken in response to COVID-19 and quarantining of individuals, for public safety, public health, health care, human services, and similar employees whose services are substantially dedicated to mitigating or responding to the COVID19 public health emergency
- Expenses to improve telework capabilities for public employees to enable compliance with COVID-19 public health precautions
- Expenses of providing leave under the FFCRA, Act 17 of 2020, or other statute requiring the leave be provided to public employees to enable compliance with COVID-19 public health precautions
- Expenses for care for homeless populations provided to mitigate COVID-19 effects and enable compliance with COVID-19 public health precautions
- Increased Worker's Compensation cost due to COVID-19
- Unemployment compensation costs due to COVID-19

Please note that this list of eligible activities is not all-inclusive. The Adams County Community Evaluation Team will review each application and any supporting documentation to determine eligibility.
