

Where/How to Recycle if You're a Business or in Construction...?

ACT 101 – Businesses are asked to report any and all recycling efforts. If your recycling occurs within a particular municipality, the information should be reported to that municipality. If you recycle materials that may be generated from numerous locations throughout Adams County, please report your information to the Environmental Services Department. For additional information, please contact our office at 717-337-9827.

Burning – Open burning of any construction/demolition waste is **prohibited** by State law. Call our office at 337-9827 for disposal options.

Carpet Tiles – Are you installing new flooring? Rather than disposing of the old carpet/tiles in a landfill, recycling options are available through:
