


Recycle Magazines to Benefit Ronald McDonald House Charities of PA

Any glossy/slick paper can be placed in this bin – magazines, inserts that are part of your daily newspaper delivery or come in the mail, catalogs, etc. However, please – DO NOT throw any other materials in this bin such as trash, regular newsprint, can tabs,

boxes, etc. ONLY GLOSSY/SLICK PAPER MATERIALS CAN BE ACCEPTED! Proceeds from this program benefit the operational expenses of Hershey Ronald McDonald House®, located across the street from Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital. Since 2002, over \$73,000 has been raised to help keep families close to their children during times of severe medical crisis.

Recycle Left-over Yarn & Cotton Material through Project Linus

If you're a crafter and have left-over new yarn or cotton material, consider donating it to the local chapter of Project Linus. (Many times, even small pieces/amounts can be used in blankets in various ways.) Yarn/Materials cannot contain any wool and must be free from contaminants. Special care should be taken to insure everything is free of smoky smells or any chemicals which could cause problems for a child.
