...use to tie plants up in the garden...

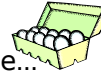
...as a dust rag...

...great to store leftovers for reheating...

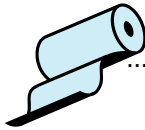
...punch holes in lid and catch Fireflies...
