
**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF ABBOTTSTOWN, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
PROMOTING THE GROWTH OF WILDFLOWERS ALONG ROADS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS;

The natural beauty of native wildflowers in Abbottstown Borough can be enjoyed by everyone; can attract guests, and benefit commerce, environmental health, and public well-being; and

The enjoyment of native wildflowers is an occasion for all borough and community leaders to unite for the benefit of everyone; and

Increasing the visibility of native wildflowers in Abbottstown Borough is consistent with the vision of the county and state conservation activities and goals of many individuals, businesses, and community-based organizations; and

The presence of native wildflowers is essential to the fitness of native pollinator species necessary for productive and profitable farms and forests; and

It is desirable and attainable to experience the beauty of many more native wildflowers by reducing the frequency and extent of roadside mowing; and


Lands along Route 194, Route 30, Sutton Road, Country Club Road, Brough Road and more are ideal candidates to establish pilot project corridors for management of native wildflowers;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Abbottstown Borough Council do hereby commit and encourage others to commit to the conservation of roadside native wildflowers on state and borough roadways, and do hereby instruct borough staff to partner with the adjoining property owners to plan and implement roadside management practices that will increase the visibility and enjoyment of native wildflowers. Residents and property owners desiring to participate are encouraged to contact the Borough Office for registry so their properties may be so identified as enrolled in this Wildflower Conservation Program (WCP).


