ORDINANCE NO. 2018 - 2**

**AN ORDINANCE OF BUTLER TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
PROVIDING FOR AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH
BIGLERVILLE BOROUGH, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA FOR EXCHANGE OF
SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Biglerville Borough, Adams County, Pennsylvania ("Borough") is a duly formed and existing Pennsylvania municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, Butler Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania ("Township") is a duly formed and existing Pennsylvania municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, Borough has need for certain repairs to alleys and streets within the Borough, which Township has the capability to perform; and

WHEREAS, Township has need for certain repairs and improvements to the joint sanitary sewer system that services both Township and Borough, which Borough has the capability to perform.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted, by the Board of Supervisors of Butler Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Board of Supervisors of Butler Township hereby approves and authorizes and directs its Chairman and Secretary to execute and deliver an intergovernmental cooperation agreement, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A," and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth, entitled "Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement for the Exchange of Services" ("Agreement").

SECTION 2: The terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement are those as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" and are made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: The initial term of the Agreement is for one year and may be extended up to a total of five years as provided in Section 5 of the Agreement (Exhibit "A").

SECTION 4: The purposes and objectives of the Agreement are to provide Township and Borough with the ability to exchange road maintenance services and sewer maintenance services to the benefit of each municipality.

SECTION 5: The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and should any section, subsection, clause, sentence or part be held or declared illegal, invalid and unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect nor impair any of the remaining sections, subsections, clauses, sentences or parts. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, subsection, clause, or sentence or part had not been included.


SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its enactment.


