

Minutes of the October 10, 2006 Meeting

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Gregor. Present were Supervisors Weikert and Underwood; Flo Ford, Carol Merryman, Mike Galassi, and Scot Pitzer from the Gettysburg Times. Supervisors Shealer and Waybright were absent. The meeting was tape-recorded.

Mrs. Underwood made a motion to approve the Minutes of the September 26, 2006 meeting as presented, seconded by Mr. Weikert and carried.

Mrs. Underwood made a motion to approve the bills list in the amount of \$117,228.29 from the General Fund and \$2,101.50 from the Park and Rec seconded by Mr. Weikert and carried.

Sergeant Molloy presented a written and oral report of police activities for the month of September including: 225 complaints and 90 combined arrests. He also reported that the department patrolled 6,891 miles of roads.

No visitors addressed the Board.

Budget workshops were scheduled for October 26 and November 6, 2006 at 7:00 p.m.

The November 24, 2006 workshop was re-scheduled for November 22, 2006 because of the Thanksgiving holiday. The November 10, 2006 workshop will be held as advertised, but the office will be closed for Veteran's Day.

Mrs. Ford reported that she has been working on the budgets for both the Township and the Authority and will be adopting the Township's new Personnel Manual for the Authority as well. She also reported that the surveyors are writing the easement description for the Sachs Mill Bridge trail and the easements will go to the Park Service for their approval. When the easements have been approved by the Park, then she will meet with the neighbors.

The Zoning Officer's report and Assistant Secretary's report for September were reviewed.

Chairman Gregor reminded everyone of the Conditional Use hearings for Jayanti, Jyoti and Raju Thakor Patel and Jayjyoti Corporation scheduled for October 25, 2006 at 7:00 p.m.

Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m. by motion of Mr. Weikert, seconded by Mrs. Underwood and carried.
