

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given by the Board of Supervisors of Cumberland Township that it will hold a public hearing on February 27, 2018, at 7:00 P.M. at the Township Office at 1370 Fairfield Road, Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania to receive public comment on the proposed repeal of the Cumberland Township Traffic Impact Fee Ordinance and associated modifications to the Cumberland Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance. The Board of Supervisors will consider for adoption and vote upon the enactment of the proposed ordinance as fully set forth below immediately following the public hearing on February 27, 2018 during the regular meeting of the Township at said Township Office. The regular meeting of the Township Board of Supervisors shall commence immediately following the conclusion of the public hearing.

The title of the proposed Ordinance is: **“AN ORDINANCE OF CUMBERLAND TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 22, PART 4, SECTION 413, OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CUMBERLAND CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED “TRAFFIC IMPACT STUDIES” AND REPEALING CHAPTER 25 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CUMBERLAND CODE OF ORDINANCES, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE CUMBERLAND TOWNSHIP TRAFFIC IMPACT FEE ORDINANCE IN ITS ENTIRETY”.**

If enacted, the Ordinance will repeal Chapter 25 of the Township of Cumberland Code of Ordinances otherwise known as the Cumberland Township Traffic Impact Fee Ordinance. The proposed Ordinance will also amend various section of Chapter 22, the Cumberland Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance, Part 4, Subsection 413 entitled “Traffic Impact Studies” to remove references to the requirements of the Cumberland Township Traffic Impact Fee Ordinance.
