✚ July Secretary Luncheon: Ms. Groft said that there were 12 out of 19 townships represented at the luncheon. She said they got seven evaluations turned in. From the responses, everyone enjoyed it, they

liked the format and interaction and are happy that an attorney was in attendance. They mentioned changing the date to earlier in July or sometime in September.

✚ 2019 Conference: Ms. Groft said the mailings to vendors and townships are out and they have received 12 ads back from individuals. Two (2) of the three (3) premium ads have been taken. The entertainment will be the magician, River Barry, from Olivia's for \$300.00 which was budgeted. She said sometime in October we will need to do proof reading and go over the agenda. Ms. Groft said the guest letters will be mailed out on September 11, 2019. Gift cards will be purchased closer to the conference date for door prizes.

- Finance – Bruce Hartman, Chairman: Mr. Hartman said there was nothing to report.
- Nominations – Chair Vacancy – Ms. Moyer said she is getting ready to send an email out to all the members regarding the November conference and questioned both John Aldridge and John Gormont if they would be willing to serve for another year.
