

HAMILTONBAN TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
Ordinance No. 2008- 01

An ordinance amending the Hamiltonban Township Zoning Ordinance relating to historical marker signs and the placement of building permit placards.

Whereas the Board of Supervisors of Hamiltonban Township finds it to be necessary and desirable to revise provisions of the above referenced ordinance to provide additional criteria for the aforementioned items, and

Whereas after public hearings held, the Hamiltonban Township Board of Supervisors finds the following ordinance necessary,

Now, therefore, be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Hamiltonban Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

Section 309.A.1.j. shall be added to read as follows:

“Historical markers as recognized by local, state or federal authorities. Said signs shall be permitted in all districts provided the size of any such sign is not in excess of twenty (20 sq.ft.) square feet.”

Section 501.J shall be amended to read as follows:

“In addition to the building permit, a placard shall be issued through the Township which will be displayed on the premises during the time construction is in progress. This placard shall show the number of the building permit, the date of its issuance and be signed by the Building Code Officer.”

In all other respects, the Hamiltonban Township Zoning Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately following enactment as provided by law.
