

INTER-MUNICIPAL COOPERATIVE POLICE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 2nd day of December, 2008 by and between the TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTONBAN, Adams County Pennsylvania, and the BOROUGH OF CARROLL VALLEY, Adams County, Pennsylvania.

WITNESSETH, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Police officers may enter and act as police officers in the other municipality without prior request when the circumstances constitute an emergency or upon the occurrence of any violation in a police officer's presence. The authority herein granted is in addition to and an expansion of the power and authority conferred by Act 141 of 1982 (42 PA CSA 8951 et seq.), "Municipal Police Jurisdiction."

2. Nothing herein shall limit the power of the chief law enforcement officer of the municipality, or his delegate, from re-assigning or recalling any officer who has entered into the municipality pursuant to a mutual aid request or under any other circumstance stated in this agreement.

3. This agreement shall continue in effect until terminated by either party. To terminate this agreement either party must notify the other in writing thirty-days (30) prior to the date of termination.

4. The persons hired by each municipality shall be compensated directly, and for the purposes of all fringe benefits, by the hiring municipality and shall be covered by such liability insurance as shall be in effect for the hiring municipality, regardless of the location of services or shared services contemplated hereinafter.

5. In the event any specific provision of this agreement is found to be unconstitutional or invalid, it is the intent of the parties that all other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
