



Laws signed

Governor Tom Wolf signed Act 107 of 2019 which will allow hunting on three Sundays. The bill allows hunting on one Sunday during rifle deer season, one in statewide archery deer season and a third to be determined by the Pennsylvania Game Commission. Hunters will need written permission from a landowner for Sunday hunting. The law will take effect February 25, 2020.

In addition, Pennsylvania will allow landowners to legally notify hunters and others that they are trespassing by painting purple stripes on the trees or posts. According to usnews.com,

"The purple stripes must be vertical lines at least 8 inches long and 1 inch wide. They must be 3 to 5 feet off the ground, readily visible to a person approaching the property and no more than 100 feet apart. The law applies everywhere, except in Philadelphia and Allegheny County. Numerous other states have adopted a purple-paint law, and paint manufacturers have formulated cans of spray paint and brush paint specifically marketed as "no hunting" paint."

- Approved Resolution #6 adopting a Police and Borough Vehicles Accompaniment/"Ride-Along" Policy
- Approved Resolution #7 appointing Craig F. Rosendale as delegate and Charlene Westcott as alternate to the Adams Council of Governments (ACCOG)
- Approved Resolution #8 Eliminating employee contributions to the Police Pension Plan for 2020
- Approved Resolution #9 appointing Council Vice-President Charlene Westcott as delegate and Council President ProTem Craig Rosendale as alternate to the Adams County Tax Collection Committee
- Approved Resolution #10 appointing Council Member David Westcott as delegate to the York Adams Tax Bureau Committee
- Appointed Philip Martin, as a member to the Zoning Hearing Board with a term to end 01/01/2023
- Approved Resolution #11 authorizing and directing the emergency succession of municipal officers and the continuity of municipal government
- Approved Resolution #12 mandating that the Borough of Littlestown prepare, maintain and keep a current emergency operations plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster with the borough
- Approved financial security for Stoners Farm Phase 5 in the amount of \$96,585.50 and Phase 6 in the amount of \$100,970.10

PAYMENT PLAN REMINDERS

- We must receive the signed stub with the first payment on or before the first due date to be considered on the payment plan
- If you send half a payment with no signed stub, you are NOT considered on the payment plan
- We apply all proper payments received
- We will NOT assume you want the payment plan based on your payment amount, you must submit the signed stub
- You may pay online, by mail, bill pay, walk in or drop off, regardless of payment method, we still must receive the original signed stub before the first due date
- Payment plans do NOT roll over, they must be completed each billing quarter
- All late payments will receive penalty, no exceptions
- Payment plans due dates are written out on the bill
- Make sure to follow the payment plan due dates on the bill, it is NOT always the last business day of the month for the SECOND payment.

BILLING REMINDERS

- All reprints will cost \$1.00, cash or check
 - We are NOT responsible for mail delivery, if you are not receiving your bills, please contact the post office
 - You will receive bills the following months; January, April, July, October
 - Tenants may not change the bill into their name
 - We cannot print and/or mail additional copies to tenants or family members
 - Water softeners
 - Leaking toilets (not all running toilets are heard)
 - Dripping faucets and/or outside spigots
- If you are concerned about your Water and Sewer bill, please check the following:**
- How often is your water softener regenerating?
 - How often are you watering your flowers or garden?
 - Did you use a power washer?
 - Did you fill a pool?
 - Have you had an increase in the number of guests?
 - Check all hose spigots outside for drips or leaks
 - Check all faucets inside the house for drips or leaks
 - Check under all sinks for any visible leaks
 - Dye test all toilets to ensure the flapper isn't leaking

Things that may affect your Water and Sewer bill

- Watering flower beds and gardens
- Washing vehicles
- Using sprinklers
- Filling pools
- Increased amounts of company


