The Borough of Littlestown will be closing on Thursday, February 21st and Friday, February 22nd to start the process of moving to 41 South Columbus Avenue. The phone system will be down for a majority, if not all of the day on February 21st.

As long as the move goes without interruption the Borough Office will resume operations on Monday, February 25th at 41 South Columbus Avenue, we will keep you posted of any changes.

Please note the following:

- Individuals on water/sewer payment plans, the February payment is still due on February 28th.
- The meetings of the Littlestown Borough Council, Littlestown Borough Authority, Planning Commission, and I & I Committee will still take place at 10 South Queen Street, until otherwise notified and advertised.
- The Police Office will still operate out of 10 South Queen Street until their portion of the building at 41 South Columbus Avenue is completed. Another notice will be released once the move date for the police department is confirmed. Therefore, in the meantime, there will only be access to the police department from 8am to Noon Monday thru Friday. If you need an officer aside from those hours you will need to contact the non-emergency number at (717) 624-2101.
