FROM THE DESK OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND BOROUGH MANAGER

Dear Borough Residents,

First of all, on behalf of the Police Department and the staff of the Borough we hope you had a Merry Christmas and we wish you a happy and healthy New Year. To say the least 2020 has been challenging and hopefully 2021 will have a better outcome. Despite the challenges of this past year we were able to get a lot accomplished in the Borough, that desperately needed to get completed.

The Borough completed the upgrades to the South Queen Street lift station which included installing new sewer lines that currently existed as well as additional new line which will be utilized to service new customers in the future. This project also included the demolition of the old lift station and construction of a new station. The cost of the project was approximately 1.75 million dollars.

The Borough was able to repair and replace several streets last year and will continue this year when weather permits. Last year we were able to totally replace Maple Ave, Park Ave., Ocker Ave, Prince St. and part of South Columbus. Repairs were also made on Myrtle St., Cemetery St. and Newark St. The Borough also awarded contracts for the replacement and new installations of 40 additional Handicapped curb ramps located throughout town which has been funded by Community Development Block Grant funding. The Borough also worked with Pennsylvania Department of Transportation during the King and Queen Streets repaving project.

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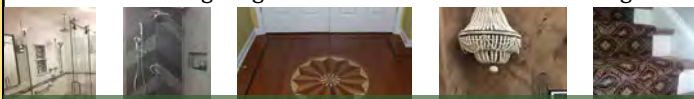

Unfortunately, a blight effected over 60 of our mature trees located in our community park which had to be removed by our Borough crew. The borough did receive some grant funding for the replacement and new trees will be planted in the spring. All of the construction areas in the park have been repaired as a result of the new sewer lines, however additional lines will be placed on the back side of the park next year which will complete this portion of the upgrades in that area.

If you haven't heard the 2021 budget has been implemented with no tax increase to Borough residents, in addition the Borough thru ordinance eliminated the Per-Capita tax in an effort to assist its residents. All water and sewer rates will remain the same with no increases for 2021.

On the Law enforcement side, the Borough hired Officer Geoffrey Smith who replaced Officer Owens. Officer Smith has completed his training and is now patrolling the streets of Littlestown, please be sure to introduce yourself to Officer Smith if you see him around town.

On behalf of the Police department I would like to thank everyone who help support our projects aimed to help support our residents. Last year we participated in the 14th annual 'Bag the Bounty' food drive that was very successful and the Marine Corp. Toys for Tots Toy Drive which to was very successful. These programs are run by our Borough Officers who volunteer their time to these worthwhile events. As you all are aware it has been a very difficult time for Law Enforcement Officers with everything that has been going on Nationwide. As Chief I would like to personally thank the community for their continued support and acts of kindness shown towards the Department and its Officers. I can assure you it did not go unnoticed by the Officers.

Hopefully 2021 will be the year we get our freedom back and we can resume our normal activities which include parades, Good Old Days, Christmas on the Square etc. However, that remains to be seen as I write this article. I will say some of the plans for this year include additional road repairs and replacement, upgrades to the Community Park, continued upgrades to our water and sewer system to name a few. Requirements: Membership of the Board must be a resident of Littlestown Borough and must be from the Ward that the vacancy exists in.

ZONING HEARING BOARD

- 1 resident – Member Position – *term to expire (01/01/2023)*
- 1 resident – Alternate Position – *term to expire (01/01/2021)*
- 1 resident – Alternate Position – *term to expire (01/01/2022)*

Requirements: The membership of the Board shall consist of three residents of the municipality appointed by the Littlestown Borough Council. Their terms of office shall be three years and shall be so fixed that the term of office of one member shall expire each year. The Board shall promptly notify the governing body of any vacancies which occur. Appointments to fill vacancies shall be only for the unexpired portion of the term. Members of the Board shall hold no other office in the municipality, except that no more than one member of the Board may also be a member of the Planning Commission.

NOTICES FROM THE CODE OFFICER

TREE TRIMMING

We have an abundance of properties that need trimming on the low hanging limbs over the street.

Trimming of trees on private property. All trees standing upon private property in this Borough having branches projecting into the public highways or public places shall be kept trimmed by the owner or occupant of such private property to such an extent that the lowest branches of such trees shall not come within (7)seven feet of the ground where they overhang any public sidewalk, public place, or 12 feet over a public highway, and to prevent the limbs from hanging lower at any time, even in wet weather, than the space specified. (Code of the Borough of Littlestown)

FIRE PITS

Fire Pits are becoming very popular this time of year. As a friendly reminder you still need approval and a permit from the borough office to have a fire pit within the borough limits. Please keep in mind we are currently revising the requirements and regulations of fire pits within the borough. More information will be shared once it is finalized.

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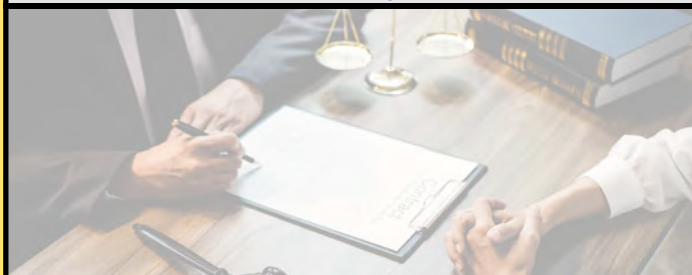
