

ORDINANCE NO. 7-90

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE MARKING OF HOUSES AND MAILBOXES WITHIN MOUNT PLEASANT TOWNSHIP WITH THE ADDRESS NUMBER OF THE HOUSE AND MAILBOX.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

ARTICLE I - SHORT TITLE

This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "MOUNT PLEASANT TOWNSHIP HOUSE NUMBERING ORDINANCE".

ARTICLE II - DISPLAY OF HOUSE NUMBER OR ADDRESS

The house number or address of the residence or dwelling shall be displayed on the house and mailbox. These numbers shall be of contrasting color to the mailbox and house and shall be no less than three (3) inches in height. On mailboxes, the number shall be displayed on both sides and on houses, the number shall be affixed to the house so as to be visible from the roadway. Where a home is located more than 300 feet from a roadway, the house need not be marked, however, if more than one home is located on a common drive, all houses must be marked so as to be visible from the lane or common drive.

ARTICLE III - NOTIFICATION OF NON-COMPLIANCE

Upon notification of non-compliance by a member of the Board of Supervisors and/or their authorized representatives, the notified party shall have fifteen (15) days to comply with this ordinance. This notification may be in written or oral form.

ARTICLE IV - NOTICE OF REQUIREMENTS

Upon issuance of a building permit, the Township Building Permit Officer shall inform the person to whom the permit is issued of the requirements of this ordinance.

ARTICLE V - PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

Any person who shall violate the provisions of Article II hereof shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of no less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than one (1) day. Any person who shall violate the provisions of Article III hereof

shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days. Provided: Each days violation of either Article II or Article III of this ordinance shall constitute a separate violation.

ARTICLE VI - COMPLIANCE WITH ORDINANCE

Residents shall have a period of thirty (30) days from adoption of this ordinance to comply with same.
