

Winter Weather & General Safety

- Please place all trash bag/cans along the street **INFRONT** of snow banks. It is a safety hazard for loaders to climb in, or over, snow banks.
- Avoid using white bags during periods of heavy snow. They are not always visible to our loaders.
- In the event of inclement weather conditions which would prevent collection, updates are posted on our web site at www.neiderersanitation.com and on our telephone at 717.624.7430. The Borough office will also have up to date information.
- Please use extreme caution when driving around all garbage trucks.

IMPORTANT — Additional Safety Issues - Please Read

Please keep cans and/or containers covered. The added weight of rain and snow can make cans extremely heavy and overweight, which is a safety issue for our crews. Overweight cans will not be collected and will be tagged. It will be your responsibility to remove contents to make the can /container within the acceptable weight limit.

Drilling small drain holes in the bottom of cans/containers may help alleviate overweight issues related to rain and snow.

Holiday Schedule

We observe the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Collection services **WILL NOT** be made on these days. If your collection falls on any of these days, collection will be made the following day.

Bulk Items

A bulk item is defined as an item that does not easily fit into a 32 gallon size trash bag. You are limited to one bulk item per week.

The following items are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**

- Televisions and any computer related device
- Freon containing products
- Propane tanks
- Scrap Metal
- Exercise Equipment
- Batteries
- Tires on rims
- Carpet / Carpet padding

Other items may apply to this list. Please contact the Borough with questionable items.
