


JD Eckman Inc. will be working for PennDOT on the above referenced project. It is scheduled to resume operations on/about the week of 2-March 2020 and is expected to finish by November of 2020. The project consists of milling and resurfacing the existing roadway and shoulders, drainage, guide rail, base replacement, and other miscellaneous construction for State Route 94, Section 31, in Adams County, Berwick, Hamilton, and Oxford Townships. The majority of this work will be done with flagging operations.

However, we will have two separate weekends (beginning at 9 pm on Friday and reopening by 6:00 am on Monday) whereas the entire roadway will be closed and detoured.

THE FIRST SCHEDULED WEEKEND DETOUR IS PRESENTLY SCHEDULED TO BEGIN ON 6-MARCH 2020 AT 9:00 PM WITH THE ROADWAY BEING REOPENED BY 6:00 AM ON MONDAY 9-MARCH 2020. THE IMPACTED SECTION OF ROADWAY WILL BE BETWEEN BRICKYARD ROAD AND US ROUTE 30. A DETOUR WILL BE POSTED FOR THE TRAVELING PUBLIC. PLEASE REFERENCE THE ATTACHED DOCUMENT FOR A NARRATIVE OF THE DETOUR ROUTE. THE DATE FOR THE SECOND WEEKEND DETOUR HAS NOT BEEN DETERMINED BUT IS NOT ANTICIPATED FOR A LEAST ANOTHER 2 MONTHS.
