

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **TYRONE TOWNSHIP ON-LOT SEWAGE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM OWNERS**

#### **REQUIRED INSPECTION**

Tyrone Township property owners in On-Lot Sewage Management System District 2 are hereby reminded that your System must be inspected by June 30, 2021 by a Tyrone Township registered pumper/hauler.

Tyrone Township property owners in On-Lot Sewage Management District 3 are hereby notified that your System must be inspected between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022 by a Tyrone Township registered pumper/hauler.

A registered Tyrone Township registered pumper/hauler will determine if your On-Lot Sewage Management System must be pumped. After payment for services rendered, registered pumper/haulers are required to submit reports of their inspection results to the Township.

Tyrone Township's On-Lot Sewage Management Ordinance No. 2016-01 and Ordinance 2020-05 are designed to comply with the mandated Clean Streams Law and the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act.

Please select only one of the Tyrone Township registered pumper/haulers from the list of registered pumper/haulers to ensure that Tyrone Township receives the information that it needs to comply with Act of 1937, P.L. 1987, No. 394 and Act of 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, as amended known as "Act 537."
